

Every unit. One record.

A handover programme tracker for RDD — from CM forecast through joint inspection, snag closure and opening.

— One mall. Every unit. Every date.



The programme is scattered across too many places.

Forecasts, cut plans, inspection evidence, snags, emails and opening dates drift apart. Handoverr brings them back to one dependable unit record.

Less chasing. Clearer accountability.



See the whole chain before it slips.

Track the contracted baseline, CM forecast, PD agreement, RDD inspection, tenant fit-out and actual opening on one continuous programme.

— Plan → inspect → fit out → open



One shared inspection record.

CM, PD and RDD review the same unit, the same cut plan and the same site condition — with the result recorded once.

— CM → PD → RDD → Tenant



Evidence stays attached to the work.

Inspection photos, snag ownership, due dates, closure evidence and verification remain connected to the unit they belong to.

— Open issue → action → verified close

One unit. Full context.

Dates, cut plans, IFC drawings, inspection reports, snags, sign-off records and opening evidence — available without rebuilding the story.

Documents and decisions in one place.



Put the units at risk first.

Surface late cut plans, overdue handovers, unresolved snags and openings due in the next four weeks before routine work fills the day.

— The exceptions lead the agenda.



Readiness becomes visible.

See the status mix by floor, zone, phase and parcel. Drill from the mall view to the unit record without losing the programme context.

Portfolio → mall → floor → unit



One operating view across every mall.

Compare opening risk, handover progress and priority intervention across projects while each mall keeps its own detailed operating record.

— Multi-project from day one.



From forecast to opening — under control.

A calm, auditable handover programme for the people who must prove what is ready, what is late and what opens next.

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
